### EXPERIENCE

Mr. Freddie Grimm is the Director of Research Operations for SRNL. In this role, he has overall leadership responsibility for all nuclear and non-nuclear laboratory facility operations. He is also responsible for strategic infrastructure planning and development, as well as project management activities at SRNL. Mr. Grimm also serves as the chairman of the SRNL Nuclear Facility Operations Safety Committee.

Mr. Grimm began his career in the site utility and production nuclear reactor programs at the Savannah River Site, where he served as a manager in the engineering and maintenance organizations. Prior to his current assignment, Mr. Grimm served as the SRNL Facility Maintenance Manager and as the SRNL Facility Manager. He also served as the Engineering Department Manager for the Facility Support Services Division, which provided engineering, waste and environmental, and project management services for SRNL and for SRS's Central Analytical Laboratory. Most recently, he served as the Chief Engineer for SRNL and was responsible for providing programmatic and strategic engineering leadership and direction for SRNL engineering and project management activities.

Mr. Grimm served on the FBI's Scientific Working Group for the Forensic Analysis of Radioactive Materials from 2004 to 2010, and was the co-chair of the Infrastructure and Facilities Working Committee. The mission of this committee was to develop strategies and guidelines for the effective, coordinated use of Federal scientific resources for responding to acts of radiological terrorism. He lead the engineering and project management efforts at SRNL to establish the first US traditional forensic examination laboratory of radioactively contaminated evidence
