Bethmann has over 29 years' experience in leadership, management, and technical direction of diverse organizations in both government and commercial industry, including Department of Energy and nuclear power and fossil-fuel sites. He has over 20 years in human resources and staffing functions, which includes direction of multi-company projects involving staff coordination, human relations intervention, equal employment & discrimination claims mediation, benefits administration, compliance, and human resource information systems (HRIS).

At the Savannah River Site, Bethmann served as Human Resources Manager for the \$4.8 Billion Mixed Oxide (MOX) Fuel Fabrication Facility Project for 12 years and, earlier, as a Production Supervisor for previous SRS Management & Operating (M&O) contractors for 9 years.

Early in his career, Bethmann served for 6 years as a public safety officer and subsequently brought that law enforcement experience to the role of Qualifying Agent by the State of Louisiana Private Security Examiners for his previous employer.
